4-H Clover Kids is an exciting 4-H program for children in Kindergarten through 2nd grade. Clover Kids is designed to bring the traditional benefits of 4-H to youth who aren't yet old enough to join the traditional 4-H program.

In Texas 4-H, we emphasize providing Clover Kids with project-related learning experiences which are age appropriate. Here is a list of approved 4-H projects for Clover Kids:

*\* It is important to note that Clover Kids are not allowed to participate in competitive 4-H events.*
