Open Shows

Open shows do not require 4-H membership, therefore, the Extension Office is not able to request eligibility and/or an excused absence for these events. A letter may be sent on behalf of the member demonstrating that these events support the 4-H members project work, however, the decision will remain up to the school (as with all requests).

If you have questions or concerns, please contact your school first, as the school has final say on eligibility. Once you have contacted the school, please contact the Extension Office.

SWINE VALIDATION

At validation the following must be present:

- 1. Animal being validated
- 2. **Registration papers** for Breeding Animals
- 3. **Parent/guardian** must be present to sign paperwork.
 - Parents may sign for exhibitor if child cannot attend
 - Parents unable to attend must sign waiver & paperwork before validation
 - Agents CANNOT sign on behalf of parent

Anyone with conflicts, must NOTIFY the extension office PRIOR to validation. Showing up at the wrong date without PRIOR notice may result in your animals not being validated!
