Wilson County Extension Office policy for livestock show entries

4-H members must make an entry appointment during the selected days and times posted. **Appointments are required** due to the large number of entries received to <u>reduce wait times</u> for members, <u>ensure thorough analyzation/completion of all forms</u>, and <u>ensure the correct amount of</u> <u>money is collected per exhibitor</u> to enter the show(s).

Last day of entry appointments (**November 9th at 5 pm for 2023**) is the last possible time the Extension office will receive entry paperwork (not including WCJLS baked food show). After the last day, the office will charge <u>\$50 per exhibitor submitting late entry forms</u> to the office as long as the desired stockshow's entry date has not past.

2023-2024 Eligibility Guidelines

We advise all Wilson County 4-H members to inquire with their school on 4-H events and activities eligibility requirements.

No Pass, No Play

As always, 4-H events will follow the No Pass No Play guidelines. Keep your grades up!

Open Shows

Open shows do not require 4-H membership, therefore, the Extension Office is not able to request eligibility and/or an excused absence for these events. A letter may be sent on behalf of the member demonstrating that these events support the 4-H members project work, however, the decision will remain up to the school (as with all requests).

If you have questions or concerns, please contact your school first, as the school has final say on eligibility. Once you have contacted the school, please contact the Extension Office.


Interested in GPS, GIS, or RS?

Used in everything from growing crops to tracking down elephants, geospatial technology is one of the fastest growing industries in the United States. Geospatial technology is used to analyze the earth's features and visualize measurements. It generally involves global positioning systems (GPS), geographical information systems (GIS), and remote sensing (RS).

GPS can tell us where we are on Earth by connecting to satellites. GIS uses computers to layer maps to help us learn more about our world. These layers can include transportation, natural resources, businesses, and people.

- Learn the basics of GPS and GIS.
- Gain practice using GPS devices.
- Learn to read and create maps.


