
State Fair Lambs/Goats- \$17/tag- due April 2nd



Open shows do not require 4-H membership, therefore, the Extension Office is not able to request eligibility and/or an excused absence for these events. A letter may be sent on behalf of the member demonstrating that these events support the 4-H members project work, however, the decision will remain up to the school (as with all requests).

If you have questions or concerns, please contact your school first, as the school has final say on eligibility. Once you have contacted the school, please contact the Extension Office.

State Updates

2024 Texas 4-H Congress

EVENT NAME: 2024 Texas 4-H Congress (Austin, TX)

EVENT DATE: July 14-17, 2024

What is Congress? Texas 4-H Congress is a four-day mock legislative experience for 4-H members going into 9th grade – through those who just graduated 12th Grade (at the time of the event). During this time, 4-H members assume the roles of legislators, lobbyists, and press corps to gain a first-hand understanding of how the legislative process works.

How to Register:

Registration for this event is very LIMITED. Due to the constraints of the venue itself, registration for this event is not open for first come, first on 4HOnline, instead each County will submit a Nomination List of the members they'd like to send to this event. **Interested participants must email Allison by March 21, 2024 if they would like to be on the nomination list**. Once all nomination lists are compiled, the District 10 Office will select our 20 delegates. Additionally, Natalie will create an alternate list in the event other Districts do not fill their slots. Accepted delegates will be notified by April 1, 2024 to begin registration on 4HOnline.

Press Corps & Lobbyist: Additionally, there are special roles for members to fill during 4-H Congress (*Email Allison if you would like a list of the roles*). Applications for the 2024 Texas 4-H Congress Press Corps and Lobbyist roles will open the week of February 15, 2024, and are due on 4HOnline on March 14, 2024. Youth who are applying for one of these roles should also place their names on their County's Nomination List, so that if they are not selected, they are still considered to attend in a different role.

Submitting a Bill: As a reminder, all youth who are planning on attending are required to submit a bill. A guide to assist in writing and developing a bill as well as the link to the submission form can be found at: <u>https://texas4-h.tamu.edu/events/congress/</u> under Bill Submissions. There are also three past Bill Books posted so that you can see some of the past Bills submitted.
