VALIDATION TAG ORDERS

Heifers- \$27/tag- due **April 2nd**

Heifers will be validated similar to steers with a tag. Previously validated heifers DO NOT have to be revalidated. **A fall heifer validation will additionally take place in October**

State Fair Lambs/Goats- \$17/tag- due **April 2nd**

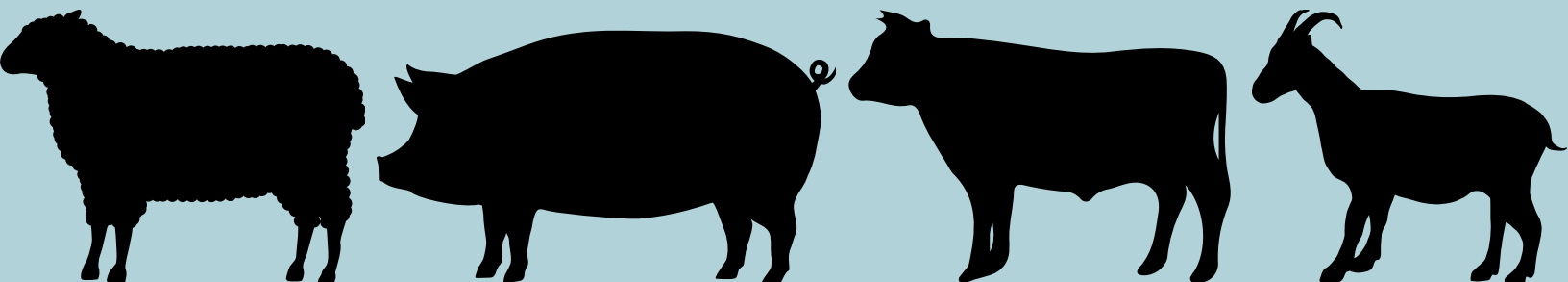
Lambs and goats validated during the 2024 State Fair validation period WILL be eligible for 2025 spring major shows as long as the animal stays in the care of the exhibitor.

Steer- \$27/tag- due **April 2nd**

State Fair Swine- \$17/tag- due **April 22nd**

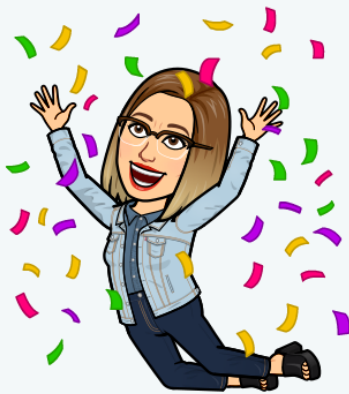
